



## **2010 & 2009 Louis Jadot offer**

Jadot is one of the great *negociant* names in Burgundy producing very good to often exceptional wines across the region including some great Beaujolais *crus* at Ch. des Jacques. The firm's resources are spread throughout the region and include some outstanding *premier and grand crus terroirs*.

Many of their top wines come from their own five domaines, Dom. des Héritiers Louis Jadot, Dom. Louis Jadot, Dom. Gagey, Dom. du Château de la Commaraine and Duc de Magenta all of which are included in the offer. The Jadot red winemaking regime, under the careful management of Jacques Lardiere & Frederic Barnier, includes a cold-soak of the fruit and then high temperature fermentations with a long maceration ensuring wines of density and power. Their minimal handling approach is carried over to the whites and oak is always very subtly employed.

### **The 2010 Vintage**

After some severe frosts over the winter the region was already facing a reduced crop by at least 25 percent. Despite a sunny April the cooler weather continued through to mid June with irregular flowering. Warm weather throughout most of July was interrupted by some light precipitation in August. Fortunately sunny weather reaching 25 degrees centigrade followed into mid October, ensuring a long but steady ripening process, *veraison*. By mid September the whites were being harvested in the Cotes de Beaune and Cotes Chalonais. Some vines were affected by rot in the south but what bunches were selected were good to excellent in quality. The grape sugars and acidity levels were high resulting in a lively freshness in the whites. The best wines show a classic character with verve and piercing fruit intensity. Quite different from the extravert, more forward 2009s. In the Cotes d'Or the reds were picked from late September. The best *crus* have deep vibrant colours, intense aromas, high fruit concentration with higher acidity than in 2009. They are classically structured burgundies with fine tannins that should age gracefully for many years.

Production was down by as much as half when compared with the bountiful 2009 vintage. The Jadot 2010s are similar in price to the 2009s but of equal quality. We recommend you order now to secure an allocation from the best that we have selected here.
