

THE 2007 VINTAGE PORT OFFER

Often the greatest vintage ports are made in those years when there is a long wet winter and cool spring. The 2007 were one of those years when the rain fell and replenished the water tables after four hot dry years. Fortunately the balance of steady warm temperatures and healthy vine growth, without the extremes of mildew onset or summer heat waves, ensured slow but complete berry ripeness. Temperatures suddenly shot up to 35-38 C in the first two weeks of September, which gave a final boost for ripening tannins and grape sugar accumulation.

All the grape varieties performed well. 'Perfect harvesting conditions with cool nights and warm days played a vital role in the final development of the grapes'. David Guimaraens, head winemaker, The Fladgate Partnership also said that 'ripening has been very even and balanced at all our properties and this is already shining through in the wines. There is excellent acidity and structure and an attractive fresh fruitiness'. Dominic Symington of the Symington Family shared similar praises 'Touriga Franca and the last grapes came in on 9th October, thus completing a vintage of virtually perfect weather.'

Christian Seely, Managing Director Quinta do Noval comments: '*Although quantity was relatively small (often less than a kilo per vine), quality is excellent, and we believe that 2007 will go down as a great year*'. '*I rate it better overall than 1977 or 1955..I give it 98 points, the same as 2003*'. James Suckling, Wine Spectator.
